



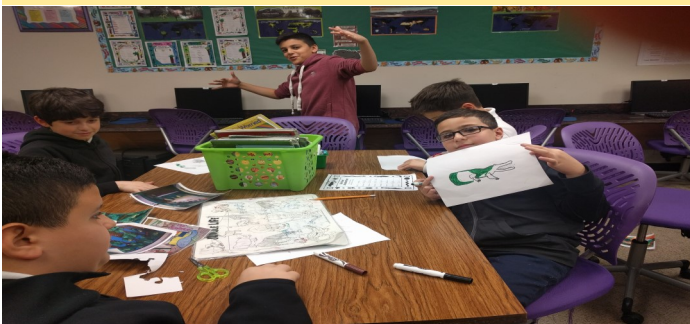
# Library Newsletter
