

Safety Measures against Covid-19

Universal School Facility Updates July 2020

Initial Preventive Measures:

- Approved ventilation in classrooms or use of air filtration systems.
- Additional Hand-Sanitizer in classrooms.
- Face masks and other PPE are to be used and are available for all staff and students.
- Disinfectant available for classrooms.

Daily Cleaning Enhancements:

- Clean and remove dirt more frequently
- Disinfect with EPA- Approved viral pathogen products.
- Bottles of disinfectant provided in classrooms with high need (early childhood, kindergarten, self-contained, etc.)
- Disinfecting of washrooms during the day in coordination with schedule of student/staff hand washing breaks.
- Disinfecting high- touch surfaces multiple times per day.
- Disinfecting desk-tops and tables after every lunch.
- Disinfect desks, tables, common touch points and floors after school daily.

Universal School Safety and Sanitation Practices: Universal School Board and Administration request all employees, vendors, visitors, volunteers or guests to abide by the recommendations provided by the CDC which include:

- Staying home if sick.
- Checking temperature daily.
- Implementing daily health check for symptoms.
- Designating an employee(s) to monitor that social distancing and increased sanitation guidelines are adhered to.
- Redesigning workflows to ensure social distancing in our workspaces.
- Additional scheduled times to hand wash

Procedure for Confirmed or Suspected Covid-19 Cases:

- Following established CDC Guidelines for cleaning and disinfecting after suspected/confirmed cases as follows:
 - Close off areas visited by ill person
 - Open Outside windows and use ventilating fans to increase air circulation.
 - Wait 24 hours ***or as long as practical*** before beginning cleaning and disinfection
- Clean and disinfect all areas, including bathrooms, offices, common areas, shared equipment.
